He attended Indiana University and then enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps. He was a golf professional at Pearl Harbor Naval Base and briefly played on the P.G.A. Tour. He was sent to Korea where he attained the rank of Sergeant and received the Purple Heart and the Silver Star. For a number of years he worked as a real estate appraiser. Marcus then became a tax administrator in Brunswick, GA and Macon, GA. He was later employed as a tax administrator for Burke County. He was a member of the Marine Corps League, Table Rock Detachment and was a member of the veterans group that met weekly through the Burke County Veterans Service Office.

He is survived by his daughter, Nancy Lynn Rankin of the home; a brother, James Rankin and wife, Janice, of TN; and sisters, Martha Rankin Kasler and husband, Lt. Col. James Kasler of Macomb, IL and Peggy Rankin York of Delray, FL.In addition to his parents, Marcus was preceded in death by his wife, Patti Lu Michael Rankin, and a brother-in-law, Jerry York.
