Ruth Oree Baker Laws, 94, of Grace Ridge, Morganton, NC and formerly of Valdese, NC, died Monday, July 17, 2017 at Grace Ridge. Born September 26, 1922 in Burke County, NC, she was a daughter of the late Robert Lon Baker, Sr. and Minnie Cline Baker. She was a graduate of Valdese High School's class of 1939 and of Blanton's Business College, Asheville, NC. For forty-four years, she was employed in the accounting office of Alba Waldensian Mills. Mrs. Laws was a faithful member of the Valdese First Baptist Church where she was a member of the Mary's Sunday School class and where she volunteered with the Twice Blessed clothing ministry.
