Albert Landon Suttle, Sr., 70, of Suttle Street, Morganton, NC, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Saturday, April 14, 2007 at his residence following a period of several months of declining health. Born in Burke County, NC on August 22, 1936, he was the son of the late James Martin Suttle and Ethel Mae Saunders Suttle.
