Charlie Wesley Bowman, 81, of Bowman Ave., Morganton, NC, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Sunday, August 06, 2006 at Grace Hospital following an extended period of declining health. Born in Old Fort, NC on October 30, 1924, he was the son of the late Joe Elbert Bowman and Lillie Mae Gurley Bowman.
