Clyde Tallent, 88, of Morganton died Sunday, February 3, 2013 following a period of declining health. He was born in Burke County on April 26, 1924 and was a son of the late Peter White Tallent and Bessie Hudson Tallent, In addition to his parents, Clyde was preceded in death by his wife, Aileen Epley Tallent; brothers, Thad and Forrest Tallent; and sister, Frances Carpenter. He was a U. S. Army veteran of World War II where he fought in five major campaigns in the European theater.
