Donald Andrew Clarke, 84, of Morganton, NC went to be with his Lord and Savior on Wednesday, December 20, 2017 at Burke Palliative Care. Born on August 26, 1933 in Burke County, he was a son of the late Julius Jennings "Jay Jay" Clarke and Elizabeth "Lizzie" Arney Clarke.

Mr. Clarke was a veteran of the United States Army where he was a combat medic attached to Special Forces. He was a life member of Mt. Pleasant United Methodist Church and American Legion.
