Evert A. Braun, 89, of NC 181, Morganton, NC died Thursday, October 22, 2009 following a short period declining health. Born in Stark County, ND on October 10, 1920, he was the son of the late Fredricke Braun and Loretta Roberts Braun. Evert was a member of St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church of which he and his wife were one of the three founding families. He was a 3rd degree member of the Knights of Columbus. Evert was a U.S. Marine Corps veteran of WWII.
