Falls W. Price, Sr., 97, of Valdese, NC passed away Sunday, January 29, 2017. Born in Cleveland County, NC on July 12, 1919, he was the son of the late Plato Rollins Price and Nettie Lee Owensby Price. Falls was a member of Drexel First Church of God. Mr. Price was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII. He survived the Battle of the Bulge and served in all five European campaigns. He owned and operated Price's Department Store and Tanglewood Trailer Park.
