



## *Floatie M. Sigman*

**Feb. 11, 1919 - July 14, 2013**

Floatie M. Sigman, 94, of Morganton, NC died Sunday, July 14, 2013. Born in Braxton County, WV on February 11, 1919, she was the daughter of the late Willie Sigman and Hattie Miranda Bowen Sigman. She attended Pleasant Hill Baptist Church. Floatie and her mother moved to Morganton in the spring of 1989 and continued to care for her mother until she died at the age of 99 ½ . She then made her home with Loretta and Grady Church; she continued to live with them until she moved into Morganton Long Term Care. She never married, had no children, and was a care-giver all her life. Floatie loved to read, travel, embroider, and was an excellent quilter. She was the last of her family to pass away.
