Rev. Howard Woodrow Wilson, 85 of Jamestown Rd., Morganton, NC went to be with the Lord on Saturday, April 16, 2011 at the V.A. Medical Center, Asheville, NC. Born February 24, 1926 in Yancey County, NC, he was a son of the late Arnold Bradley Wilson and Bonnie Belle Thomas Wilson. He was a World War II U. S.
