Hubert Anthony, 82, of Morganton, NC passed away on Wednesday, December 7, 2011 at his residence following an extended illness. Born in Lincoln County, NC on November 7, 1929, he was the son of the late Evan Elbert Anthony and Ovia Gragg Anthony. Hubert was a member of First Church of God in Drexel, where he was involved in the Montreat Sound Coordination for several years.
