Jimmy Leroy Stewart, 73, one of God's greats, lost his short battle with esophageal cancer and is now in the hands of his Lord and Savior on Friday, September 13, 2024. He was born on April 15, 1951 in Burke County to the late Raleigh Stewart and Annie Moore Stewart. He was a member of Hopewell Baptist Church and a 1969 graduate of Salem High School. He was also a member of The Gideons International-Burke West Camp. Jimmy was a loving son, brother, husband, father, grandfather and role model who made a huge impact on the Burke County community.
