Jink Franklin, 86, of Morganton passed from his earthly life to eternal life on Wednesday February 20, 2019 following a fall in October.

Classes often would walk around the block just so the school children could see the flowers. He also loved to grow vegetables and was known to grow extra just to be able to share with friends and neighbors
