John Lindsey Hall, 97, of Morganton, NC went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, December 13, 2011 at the Burke Palliative Care Center following a brief illness. Born in Metasville, GA on February 28, 1914, he was the son of the late George Teasley Hall and Sallie Rebecca Thornton Hall. John was a long time member of First Baptist Church. He was an avid gardener and specialized in raising numerous roses and flowers. For many years he was a member of the Junior Order Organization. From 1934 to 1939 he worked as a field leader in the Civilian Conservation Corps in Ruthledge, GA. He also worked several years at the ship yard in Wilmington, NC, before moving back to Morganton. Upon his return to Morganton, he worked for Drexel Heritage Furnishings making sandpaper belts until he retired.
