



## *Joseph "Paul" Scott*

**June 21, 1928 - Dec. 28, 2009**

Joseph "Paul" Scott, 81, of Morganton, passed away on Monday, December 28, 2009 at Grace Hospital following a period of declining health. Born on June 21, 1928, Paul was the son of the late John Marshall Scott and Lillie Pendley Scott.
