

Leland Wannamaker Rhame, 79, of Morganton, NC died Friday, September 13, 2024 after a short, acute medical crisis. He was born on May 31, 1945 in Camden, SC to the late Walter Ashby Rhame and Nelle Wannamaker Rhame. Mr. Rhame was the founder and former owner of Blue Ridge Audiology in Morganton. He was a 1963 graduate of Camden High School. He graduated from Wofford College in 1972 and received his graduate degree in Audiology from the University of South Carolina in 1974.
