Rena Glenn Yount Dyer, 92, of Morganton, NC died Monday, September 12, 2016. Born in Richmond, VA on February 23, 1924, she was the daughter of the late Glenn O. Yount and Mary May Yount. Mrs. Dyer was a 1946 graduate of Berea College in Berea, KY. Following her graduation, she married Dr. John Dyer of Petersburg, WV.
