July 28, 1918 - July 10, 2011

Russell Hill Watson, 92, died Sunday, July 10, 2011, following a 31 year long battle with Lou Gehrig's Disease. He was born in Spartanburg, SC on July 28, 1918 and was a son of the late Russell and Zella Hill Watson. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Edna Evelyn Wiggins Watson. Mr. Watson was a graduate of Clemson University and worked for a short time with SC Highway Patrol. He was a U. S. Army veteran of World War II and was a Purple Heart recipient. He retired from Great Lakes Carbon Corporation. As a Master Mason for 70 years, Russell was a member of Lodge 222 Enoree, SC and as a Shriner, he was a member of North Avenue Hejaz Temple in Mauldin, SC and Scottish Rite Temple in Greenville, SC. Surviving are his daughter, Peggy Watson Paul and husband, Randy, of Morganton; granddaughters, Tracy Boutin and Sandra Benfield; and great grandchildren, Summer, Marshall, and Russell Boutin and Michaela and Lexie Benfield.
