Sam Ervin Wakefield, 82, of the Oak Hill Community in Morganton, NC passed away unexpectedly Sunday, September 15, 2013. Sam was a loving father, grandfather, and great-grandfather and showed interest and took great pride in everyone's lives and accomplishments. He enjoyed camping trips with his family and attended countless sporting and other events supporting his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren throughout the years. Sam always taught by example instilling the values of honesty, respect, and service to others. He will be remembered for his smiles, hugs, and kind words by all who knew him. Sam is
