

W. H. "Bill" Lachot, Jr., 90, of Morganton, NC, passed away Saturday, December 2, 2023.

Born in Catawba County, NC on January 14, 1933, he is the son of the late Willis Henry Lachot and Lula Treat Chapman Lachot.

Bill was an active member of First Baptist Church. He was a former chairman of the board of trustees for the church, sang in the choir, and was a member of the Men's Sunday School Class. Along with his second wife, Carol, he participated in missions to Poland, Romania, and Ukraine.
